***drumMUSTER** to operate at Millicent & Penola*

Council wishes to advise that the **drumMUSTER** program will again be offered to local farmers to dispose of their eligible farm chemical containers. **drumMUSTER** is a national program which has been established to collect and recycle empty, clean, non-returnable crop protection and animal health chemical containers.

The collection services will be operating at the Penola Resource Recovery Centre on Tuesday 18<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> September, 2012 and the Millicent Resource Recovery Centre on Thursday, 20<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> September, 2012. Persons wishing to use the service simply need to contact Councils Contractor, Cleanaway on 8725 3500 to arrange a delivery time.

Chemical users need to remember their empty containers must be correctly cleaned and air-dried, as all containers will be inspected when brought into the collection centre. Any unclean or partly filled containers will not be accepted.

Council encourages all chemical users to utilise this free service. The collection service is offered twice yearly with the next program scheduled for February/March 2013
