Reason:

a: information the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead);

b: information the disclosure of which—

- (i) could reasonably be expected to confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the council is conducting, or proposing to conduct, business, or to prejudice the commercial position of the council; and
- (ii) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest;

c: information the disclosure of which would reveal a trade secret;

d: commercial information of a confidential nature (not being a trade secret) the disclosure of which—

- (i) could reasonably be expected to prejudice the commercial position of the person who supplied the information, or to confer a commercial advantage on a third party; and
- (ii) would, on balance, be contrary to the public interest;

e: matters affecting the security of the council, members or employees of the council, or council property, or the safety of any person;

g: matters that must be considered in confidence in order to ensure that the council does not breach any law, order or direction of a court or tribunal constituted by law, any duty of confidence, or other legal obligation or duty;

k: tenders for the supply of goods, the provision of services or the carrying out of works;
