# WATTLE RANGE COUNCIL HON TERRY ROBERTS MLC MEMORIAL STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP

# The Scholarship

A generous donation by the Wattle Range Council has enabled the establishment of the Wattle Range Council Hon Terry Roberts MLC Memorial Student Scholarship to recognize the contribution made by the late Hon Terry Roberts MLC to South Australia, the Wattle Range Council region and the Millicent community. The scholarship has been established to assist students from the Wattle Range Council area to commence undergraduate study at Flinders University. Subject to the availability of funds, up to five scholarships valued at \$1,000 each will be awarded annually.

## **Eligibility**

Applicants for the scholarship must:

- (a) be Australian citizens or permanent residents of Australia; and
- (b) normally reside within the boundaries of the Wattle Range Council. See the Local Government Association of South Australia website at <a href="http://www.lga.sa.gov.au">http://www.lga.sa.gov.au</a> for more information on the localities covered by this council; and
- (c) have applied through SATAC for entry to the University in the most recent admissions period; and
- (d) have completed the requirements for the South Australian Certificate of Education; and
- (e) be in their first year of higher education study and be enrolled full-time in an undergraduate course of study at Flinders University; and
- (f) be able to demonstrate financial hardship.

### **Tenure**

The scholarship is awarded for one full-time year of study (36 units) or its part-time equivalent, subject to the scholarship holder maintaining their enrolment and satisfactory academic progress.

Scholarship payments will be withdrawn if the scholarship holder withdraws or is precluded from the course and will not be available for a repeat year of study. The scholarship will be paid in instalments at the beginning of each semester.

## Source of Funds

The scholarship is funded by a donation from the Wattle Range Council.

#### Selection

The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of demonstrated financial need and academic merit, as determined by the Tertiary Entrance Rank (TER).

Selection will be made in accordance with procedures approved by the Director, Academic and Student Services and a recommendation made to Wattle Range Council for its endorsement.

## **Applications**

Applications must be made on the prescribed form available from the Higher Degree Administration and Scholarships Office, and be submitted by the specified closing date.

## **Advertising**

The availability of the scholarship will be advertised in relevant University brochures, the SATAC Guide, the Undergraduate Course Guide and will be described on the University website.
