## INFORMATION FOR ENTRANTS:

### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY –

Entries due 18th November & delivery of art work to Library Gallery by Saturday 25th November 2023

**Maximum of Five (5) Artworks per artist** – Entry Fee of \$10 per artwork. No fee for youth. No photographic works.

- 2D works must be presented ready to **hang in the gallery** (size should be no larger than 2m x 2m)
- 3D works must be portable
- Artwork must be completed within the last three years
- Each entered artwork/entry must be clearly labelled, filled out and attached to the back lower section of the work.
- The Gallery retains 20% commission for all works sold excepting youth works.
- Artworks must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition and collected after if not sold
- The Gallery reserves the right to refuse any artwork considered unsuitable, or does not comply with the rules.
- The results as determined by the judges are final and no discussion will be entered into.
- The Gallery takes no responsibility for Artworks damaged or lost during the exhibition.
- All insurance of the Artworks is the responsibility of the Artist.
- This Exhibition is Non Acquisitive and art work may be for sale. Prices must be nominated by artists.
